Date and Venue of the Race

24 August 2024, Lake Viljandi, Ranna pst 13, 71003 Viljandi, Estonia

Races are held under the U.I.M. rules. All participants, who will enter the competition, must agree and follow U.I.M. rules.

Entries

Parents signature on the entry form is mandatory for all drivers who are under 18 years. Entry fee for GT-10 and GT-15 is 40 euros and for GT-30 and OSY-400 is 50 euros. The fee must be paid during registration.

Minimum age

Minimum age for class GT-10 is 7 to 12 years, for class GT-15 the age to compete is 10 to 16 years. Other classes minimum age to compete is 16 years.

Publicity on the Boats

The organizer reserves rights for advertisements on the boats as regulated in U.I.M. Rules 203.051.

Insurance

All drivers must present their valid personal international accident Insurance Policy. If the Insurance is included on some National Authorities Racing Licenses, they must be drawn up in English.

Racing Courses

Racing course for GT-10 and GT-15 is four buoy course and one right turn.

For classes GT-10 and GT-15 the length is 1030 m.

For other classes in four buoy course with length 1500 m. For classes GT-30 there is five buoys and one right turn.

Race Format

All classes have three heats and all three are scored by the U.I.M. scoring system.

Class GT-15, GT-30 race length is 8 laps, GT-10 and OSY-400 have 5 laps.

Maximum 20 boats in one start.

Boats are taken into the water by slipway.

Starts and Restarts

All heats will have a dead engine start per U.I.M. Rule 307. The start remains open until the first racer has made three laps.

Buoys Damages

Any buoy destruction entails a payment of 200.- EUR for the driver. It must be paid to the race secretary before the next start or during the event when destruction happens in the last race.

Prizes and Prize giving Ceremony

The prize giving ceremony will take place at the race site after the technical inspections of hulls and engines. First three places will receive Cups. The prizes are given to the winner themselves only wearing their racing suits or team uniforms and decent footwear.

Protests

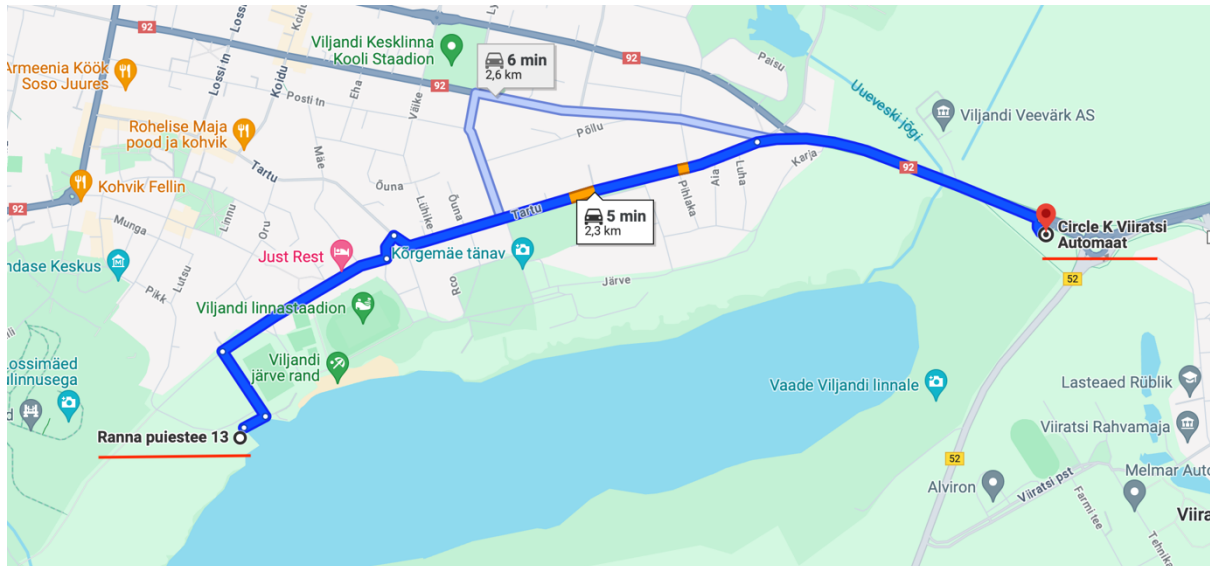
Any protests must be submitted to the Race Secretary in English according to UIM Rule 403. Protest fee is 150 EUR and it is payable in cash at the time of lodging the protest.

Noise Reductions

Every driver is responsible that his engine does not exceed noise levels at all times as specified in U.I.M. Rule 504

Fuel

Drivers in gasoline using classes use only gasoline fuel rated 98 RON. They are required to buy the fuel at the Circle K petrol station located 2,3 km from the boat park (map below). The Technical Commission will take a fuel sample for inspection from the same petrol station. Each driver should keep his bill of sale for the fuel from the above mentioned petrol station and if required, has to present it.



Environment Protections

Every driver is responsible to take care of the environment - an absorbent carpet to avoid any spillage to the ground must be used according to the U.I.M. Rules 703

Transport Facilities

No compensations for travel costs or for starting in the race will be paid.

Boat Park

Is strictly forbidden to prepare meals with camping equipment in the boat park. All drivers and crew members have to wear respectable clothing. Closed shoes on the starting grid are mandatory. In all classes every team get area 4x6 meters for the tent. Smoking and drinking alcoholic beverages is prohibited in boat park.

Accommodation

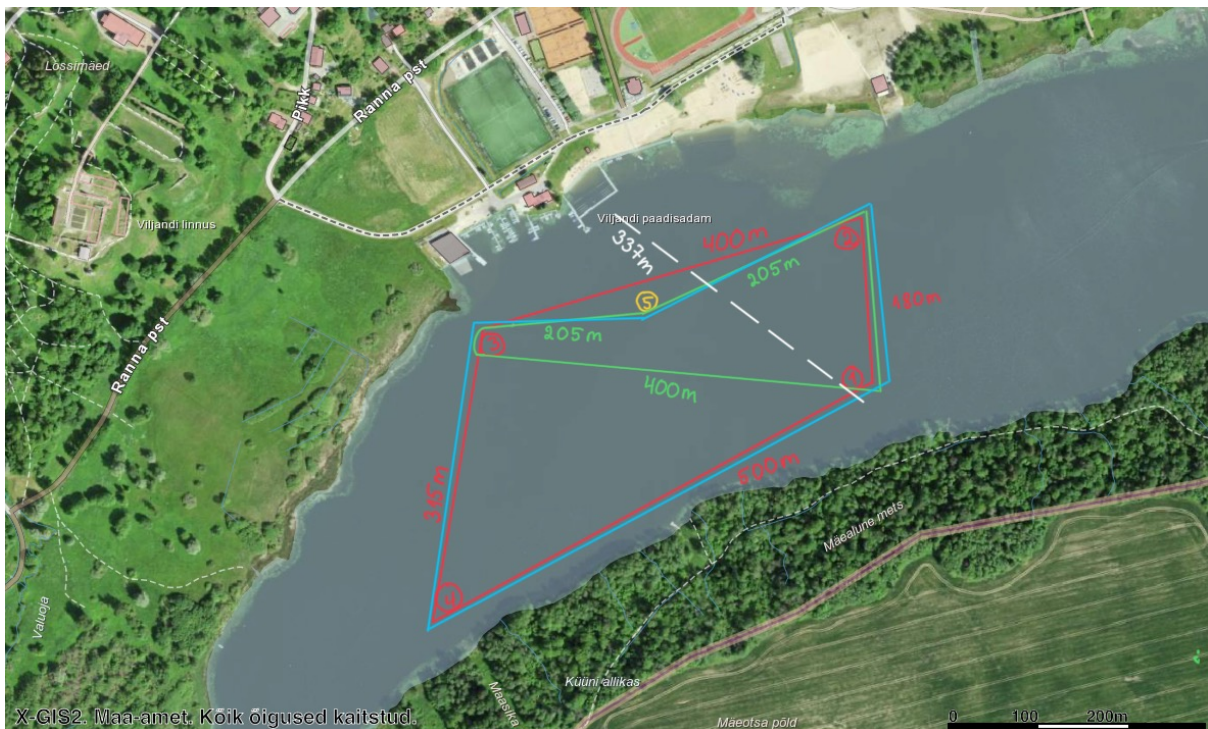
