LICENSES AND INSURANCE

Licenses: All competitors must have a valid race license issued by their national association. **One time race licenses** can be purchased **only for estonian** at the registration for the **fee of 75 €**

Insurance: All drivers must present their valid personal international accident insurance Policy in Estonian or English. Also minimum 25 000 civil insurance.

SAFETY REGISTRATION

Must have: **Colorful helmet, back protection** and **life jacket** is compulsory for all riders. **Leg protectors** are compulsory for **all Runabout riders***

Racing Number (UIM AB Rulebook 206): **Black numbers on white background or visible!**

The size of the **background** least **30cm x 30cm**. The **height of the numbers** must be (at least) **22 cm** and the **distance between the numbers** must be (at least) **13mm**. Race numbers must be accepted by the timing and race officials. and will be checked during the technical inspection. There is **possibility to buy a readable race number on-site for 25€**.

Competitors take part in EPU (Estonian Powerboating Union) competitions **on their own responsibility** except for the cases, which are regulated by contract between organizer and insurance company If P&C Insurance AS. You are solely responsible for yourself and your equipment. During official training and races there are safety boats/jetskis and an ambulance available. It is possible to check for insurance terms at the competition place or by sending a request to **evl@veemoto.ee**

MORNING BRIEFING

Taking part of the riders/pilots **briefing is mandatory**.

The aquabike O.O.D. may sanction the riders that arrive **too late** to the pilots briefing with a **penalty of 100 Euro**. This penalty must be paid before the starts.

PROTEST

Any protests must be submitted to the Race Secretary according to UIM Rule 403.

Protest fee is 150 EUR and it is payable in cash at the time of lodging the protest.

Aquabike **technical protest fee is 200€** nominated by EPU.

FINES

Destroying/ damaging **a buoy : 500.- EUR** for the rider.

Destroying/ damaging **a Safety Demarcation buoys : 900.- EUR** for the rider.

All fines must be paid to the race secretary during the event.

START

Starting position for the first heat will be chosen based on the draw order. The starting position for next heats will be chosen based on the previous race results.

The chequered flag signals the finish of the race.

GENERAL

Each registered Rider/Pilot is **responsible for** their own **aquabike** and **racing number** and **crew members**. Also to check the official notice board to be up-to-date with any documentation posted & paying attention to the signs and orders given by rescue marshals or OOD.

Every driver is responsible to take care of the environment – **an absorbent carpet must be used** – an absorbent carpet to avoid any spillage to the ground must be used according the U.I.M. Rules 703

All drivers and crew members have to wear respectable clothing. **Closed shoes on the starting grid are mandatory**. In all classes every team get an area 4x6 meters for tent. Smoking and drinking alcoholic beverages is prohibited in boat park.

Penalties may be assessed to the owner and/or rider for unsportsmanlike conduct of their crew members, families and sponsors, as well as to the offenders themselves

Unsportsmanlike conduct includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Verbal abuse (of participants, crew, family members, sponsors, officials or staff)
- Physical violence
- Threats
- Public obscene language
- Public statements or actions with a negative impact on the sport and or UIM/ABP
- Refusal to obey an order from a race official etc.

Penalties, as decided by the EPU board & UIM rulebook, unsportsmanlike conduct will be assessed by the OOD and/or AB Committee.
